St. Peter's Church, Dromiskin celebrates 100 years (Oct.4th 2026)

This will be marked by a Mass lead by Archbishop Eamon Martin on Sunday Oct. 4th at 3pm followed by a meal at 5pm in Darver Community Centre. To prepare for this historic occasion important work needs to be done to the interior of the church: **A new Lighting system in and outside the church, preceded by a comprehensive upgrade and replacement of the churches electrical wiring, a complete restoration of the mosaics in the sanctuary, many of the windows require sealing to ensure that they are air-tight.** This is a huge undertaking and will require much fundraising, private donations and sponsorship. A fund-raising team is being assembled to carry out this task but we need all parishioners to get behind this project. One of the first fund raising initiatives is '**Quid Games**' (31st May in the Fairways Hotel.) The church fundraising team will work jointly with a team representing St. Peters School who are celebrating their golden jubilee this year. You will hear much more about this in the coming weeks.

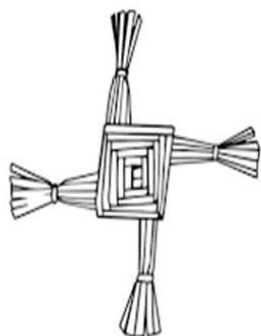
CONFESSIONS: Before monthly **Family Tree Healing Mass (Sun. 3pm Mon. 7pm)** or on request.

St Brigid of Faughart (c. 451–525), one of Ireland’s three national patrons, has a special and treasured connection with Faughart, as her birthplace. From earliest times, Faughart has been recognised as sacred ground linked to her life, faith, and mission. In Faughart, pilgrims have long prayed at St Brigid’s Shrine that speak of her deep prayerfulness, humility, and closeness to God. It was in this landscape that Brigid’s faith was first nurtured, shaping the woman who would later found the great monastery of Kildare and become a powerful witness to Christ through charity, hospitality, and service to the poor. St Brigid is remembered for her generosity, her care for the vulnerable, and her trust in God’s providence. The weaving of **St Brigid’s Cross**, still cherished in Irish homes, reflects her desire that Christ be at the centre of family and community life. On this her feast day marking the beginning of spring, reminds us that Brigid’s legacy is one of renewal, hope, and living faith. St Brigid ‘ Mary of the Gael’, pray for us.
